

# Oxley Primary School: Pupil Premium Funding 2016-17

**Number on roll (October census): 234**

**Number of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding: 33**

**Amount of grant per eligible pupil: £1320**

**Total Pupil Premium Grant 2015-16: £43,560**

NB – the total may not always equal number of pupils x amount per pupil. Some pupils arrive part-way through the year or only become eligible for the funding later in the year.

## **Objectives for Spending the Pupil Premium Grant**

- To ensure that progress and attainment of eligible pupils (FSM & Ever6) is as close as possible to that of non 'Ever 6' pupils, and in line with national expectations in reading, writing and maths, by addressing inequalities through additional opportunities and targeted support.
- To enable equal access to wider educational provision and extra-curricular opportunities provided by the school, regardless of children's financial circumstances.

## **Planned expenditure and support for 2016-17**

- Provision of additional Learning Support staff to reduce pupil:adult ratios and provide additional targeted pupil support and intervention in school and after school.
- Support for children and their families, to help them overcome difficulties at home and support those children and families with emotional or social difficulties:
  - Family Outreach Workers
  - Education Welfare Officer
  - Counsellor
- Free access to the school Breakfast Club
- Financial assistance to enable:
  - attendance at after-school clubs and sports competitions
  - holiday schemes
  - the purchasing of school uniform or kit
  - subsidising trips/residential visits.
- Staff training, in relation to supporting vulnerable pupils.
- Purchasing of educational resources (such as books, equipment, IT) aimed at supporting these pupils in school.
- Provision of additional non-contact time for teachers to meet with disadvantaged pupils, identify barriers to learning and ways of overcoming these barriers.

## **Measuring Impact**

The progress of each pupil is continually monitored and reviewed each half term. Summary reports of pupils' progress are produced termly. The overall impact of the expenditure will be evaluated at the end of this academic year (July 2017).
