







<p>English This term we will be accessing a majority of the English curriculum through our selected Novel studies. The first half of the term we will study the stories 'Silly Billy' and 'After the Fall' focusing on a well being theme through the use of character. After half term we will be doing a unit on the author Anthony Browne.</p> <p><u>Reading</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consolidating our phonetic awareness through spelling sessions. • Making predictions and inferences based on what we have read and relating them to their own experiences. • Asking questions about texts. • Exploring vocabulary. • Visualising what is happening. <p><u>Grammar, Spelling and Composition</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Punctuation focusing on capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks. • Using nouns, verbs and adjectives correctly. • Writing for different purposes. • Starting to learn the year three common exception words. <p><u>Speaking and Listening</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using standard English and speaking in full sentences. • Widening our vocabulary. • Listening to others and responding appropriately. 	<p>Science In Science this term we will be focusing on 'Animals including Humans'. We will begin by studying the different types of teeth and their different functions. This will be followed by a practical investigation to find which substances decay teeth the quickest. After half term we will move on to learn about the human digestive system.</p> 	<p>Computing We will consolidate our learning on how to log on and will be using online programmes like Purple Mash and TT Rock Stars. We will be learning about how to access and use technology safely and will be using the internet to find facts and information.</p>  <p>Modern Foreign Languages This term in French we will start to learn greetings and numbers.</p>	
<p>Mathematics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This term we will be concentrating heavily on numbers including counting and representing numbers to 1000, ordering and comparing to help consolidate their understanding of place value. We will also be counting in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, 8s and 10s. • Using addition and subtraction we will explore number facts, compare number sentences and work on our number bonds to 1000. Using the column calculation method we will also learn to add and subtract more quickly and efficiently. • We will be practising our 2,3,4,5,8,10 times tables and also be learning to recognise the inverse division relationships and use these to help solve more complex mathematical problems. • During the term we will also focus on Roman Numerals . 	<p>Design and Technology Following on from our wellbeing theme, the early part of the term will see the children making their own worry dolls. This will later be followed by the designing and creating of Viking Longships which will see the children both evaluate and suggest improvements on their work.</p> 	<p>Geography This term we will study where in the world the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings originated and which parts of England they invaded. We will use maps and atlases to locate areas within our locality that were named by the Anglo-Saxons.</p> 	
<p>Art & Design This term we will focus on our drawing and sketching skills with a particular focus on tones and shading. In relation to our Anglo-Saxon and Viking topic, we will also be learning how to weave using different papers and threads.</p>	<p>History This term we will be finding out about Britain's settlement by the Anglo Saxons, including some local studies. We will explore how they lived and compare them to the Vikings. Through artefacts and pictures we will learn about their invasions, homes, farming and their treasures.</p> 	<p>RE This term we will focus on what different people believe about God. We will have a particular focus on the beliefs and values of Hinduism, Christianity and Islam.</p> <p>PE This term in PE, and in line with COVID-19 guidelines, we will be focusing on non-invasion games. The children will build upon a variety of skills including tactics, rhythm and spatial awareness.</p>	<p>Music This term in music we will have a percussion focus and we will think about the tempo, rhythm and pitch of compositions.</p> <p>PHSE (including British Values) This term we will be studying emotions and how events and actions can affect the way that people feel. We will also be thinking about British Values and democracy. The early part of the term we will find out about chimpanzees and why they are endangered.</p>
