











**Curriculum Overview Class: Red Pandas**  
**Year Group: 5 Term: Autumn**  
**We are Marauders – Raiders and Traders**

<p><b>English</b>          Through our topic this term we will explore many different genres of writing, including an explanation text, persuasive writing and non-chronological reports. The writing process will be used to develop our editing and redrafting skills alongside our spelling, grammar and punctuation work. SPaG will also be taught in discrete sessions as well as applying these in context within our writing.</p> <p>Alongside reading in class, we will have guided reading sessions, which will enable us to explore a variety of different texts and support development of comprehension skills. The class will enjoy a class read which is currently Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets.</p> <p>Novel study will focus on Black Dog and during Autumn 1, which has a close tie in with PSHE. We will be using the internet throughout the year, so it is important we are able to use it sensibly and appropriately. After half term we will also be looking at coding and creating our own games.</p> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div>	
<p><b>Mathematics</b>          Our maths work this term will develop knowledge and understanding of place value. Alongside this, we will be working hard on arithmetic. As well as our 'Fluent in 5' work, we will use mental and written strategies to solve calculations involving all four operations, fractions and percentages so that our speed, efficiency and accuracy is improved. Reasoning will underpin all our mathematics and children will have plenty of opportunities to discuss their maths work and explain their strategies and patterns that they notice.</p> <p>Times table facts and corresponding division facts are a crucial part of mathematics. Fluency in recalling these will support the children as we work through the Year 5 curriculum; they come into so many other areas of maths. It is important that children continue to practise these, so they are confident and accurate. TT Rock Stars will enable children to practise times table fact online at school and at home.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p><b>Design and Technology</b>          We have a DT project planned for Autumn 2, where we will work through the design process and create a Viking longboat. This will be used as a platform for some English work on persuasive writing, including a speech.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p><b>Geography</b>          We will be looking at using atlases and maps to help us understand and explain the journeys made by Anglo-Saxons. We will also be looking at why the Anglo-Saxons chose the areas in which they settled.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	
<p><b>Science</b>          Our science has a biology theme this term. We will be learning all about Living things and their habitats.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p><b>History</b>          Our history topic this term is the Anglo-Saxons. We will look at the chronology of the era and explore key events such as Viking invasions, Offa's Dyke and key people such as King Alfred and Augustine.</p>	<p><b>Modern Foreign Languages</b>          We will continue to learn words, phrases and songs from a variety of different topics for our French learning this term.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p><b>Music</b>          This term we are lucky enough to be joined by a music specialist teaching us the djembe. This will continue to be a key theme through this term as we continue with our Oxley values: 'Be Kind, Be Brilliant, have an 'I Can'</p>
